**Research Analysis**

The PCS1 to HB 4463 directs the State Department of Health to utilize an amount necessary to successfully regulate and enforce all programs and provisions associated with the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority, including but not limited to, the hiring and employment of additional staff at OMMA, as well as participating in interagency agreements with state law enforcement agencies for enhanced enforcement.
