Research Analysis

The CS for HB4466 directs appropriations to the Department of Human Services. The measure directs \$32.5 million for providing Home and Community-Based Waiver services for persons with developmental disabilities and to ensure access to those served through the ADvantage Waiver. The following appropriations will also be made:

- \$2.5 million for maintaining funding levels for Senior Nutrition programs in rural communities
- \$1,001,806 for debt service obligations for the renovation and construction of the Robert M. Greer Center
- \$1.1 million for a nutrition incentive program for low income families to purchase fresh fruits and vegetables
- \$2.8 million for the Child Abuse Multidisciplinary Account
- All federal money from the TANF Block Grant and the Child Care and Development Fund Block Grant

The DHS director may request the early transfer of tax collection for early allocation of disbursing funds. The cumulative amount transferred cannot exceed the cumulative amount of equal monthly allotments from the General Revenue Fund. Appropriations may be budgeted for FY23 or FY24.

Fiscal Analysis

The CS to HB4466 directs the Oklahoma Department of Human Services to spend \$32,500,000 on the DDSD Waiting List to eliminate the list, and implement a 25% in rates for all services within HCSS Waiver to ensure access for people within ADVantage Waiver, to supplement existing funds,. \$2.5m for Senior Meals Program, and \$1,001,806 to be used to fund the debt service obligation at the Greer Center.
