Research Analysis

HJR1002 directs the Secretary of State to create a state question about amending the constitution to change the percent of legal voters needed to propose initiatives from statewide to for each county. The percentage of eight percent for legislative measures and fifteen percent for proposed constitutional amendments will remain the same, but will now be of legal voters in each county. HJR1002 also provides the ballot title and directs filing.

HJR 1002 in its current form refers to a vote of the people a proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution. The amendment itself has no direct impact on the state budget or state revenues.
