Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HJR1004 would put to a public vote an amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution that would require that any measure referred to the people by an initiative petition to amend the Oklahoma Constitution to take effect when it has been approved by a two-thirds majority of the votes case. The measure also provides a ballot title.

Fiscal Analysis

The resolution requires a two-thirds (2/3) majority for passage of an amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution when referred to the people as an initiative or petition.

The provisions of the resolution are not expected to result in measurable fiscal or revenue costs or savings. Assuming the question will be on a regularly scheduled statewide election ballot, costs to the State Election Board involving ballot printing will depend on the requirements of preparing ballots.
