Research Analysis

The amendment to HJR 1039 clarifies that eight percent (8%) of the legal voters of each congressional district of this state shall have the rights to propose a legislative measure and fifteen percent (15%) of legal voters in each congressional district in this state shall have the right to propose a constitutional amendment. A referendum may be ordered by a petition signed by five percent (5%) of the legal voters of each congressional district in this state. This measure would go up to a public vote and provides the ballot title.
