**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HJR 1039 amends the Oklahoma Constitution to state that the government shall not accept petitions for changes to state law unless proposed by petition by eight percent (8%) of legal voters and the government shall not accept petitions for constitutional changes unless proposed by petition by fifteen percent (15%) of the legal voters of each congressional district of this state. A referendum may be ordered by a petition signed by five percent (5%) of the legal voters of each state congressional district. This measure would go up to a public vote and provides the ballot title.
