Research Analysis

HJR 1039, as introduced, proposes a constitutional amendment which would change the amount of people needed to propose legislative measures and constitutional amendments. Eight percent (8%) of the legal voters of every state congressional district shall have the right to propose a legislative measure and fifteen percent (15%) of legal voters in each state congressional district shall have the right to propose a constitutional amendment. A referendum may be ordered by a petition signed by five percent (5%) of the legal voters of each state congressional district. This measure would go up to a public vote and provides the ballot title.
