**Research Analysis**

FA1 to HJR1048 puts a constitutional amendment to a public vote that would clarify that only United State citizens can vote in the state, upon providing valid identification. They may cast a single vote by secret ballot which will be solely used to determine election results. The measure also provides a ballot title.
