HJR1048, as introduced, puts an amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution up to a public vote that would clarify that only citizens of the United States, who are 18 and over and are bona fide state residents qualify as electors in this state. The measure also provides a ballot title.

Should the addition of enough state questions require the printing of a second ballot page, costs would approximately be between \$500,000 and \$550,000 statewide for the additional page, based on printing costs for the 2020 General Election.
