HJR1052, as introduced, puts to a public vote an amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution that would require any initiative petition and any measure referred to the ballot by the Legislature to describe the specific fiscal impact that the proposed amendment to statute or the Oklahoma

Fiscal Analysis

In its current form, HJR 1052 refers to a vote of the people a proposed amendment to the Constitution. The amendment is not expected to have a direct impact on the state budget or state revenues.
