**Research Analysis**

HJR1056, as introduced, repeals and nullifies the termination date for the provisions of Enrolled House Joint Resolution [No. 1043](#) of the 2nd Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature regarding an Article V Convention. After the passage of the resolution, the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives will prepare and file a copy with the Secretary of State and once copy with the Attorney General and transmit copies to the President and Secretary of the United States Senate and to the Speaker and Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, members of the Oklahoma delegation, and to the presiding officer of each legislative houses in several states, requesting their cooperation.
