**Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB103 requires an individual directed to sign an affidavit on an absentee ballot to print their name and address of residence on the affidavit. The voter signature must be witnessed by two people, who did not sign the affidavit, and their printed name, signature, and address must also appear on the affidavit. The voter will seal the ballot and return it in the same manner described in Title 26, [Section 14-108](#).
