## **Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB1032 requires a public body which maintains a website and utilizes a high-speed internet connection to stream all meetings live and post those meetings on the website, to the extent practicable.

The measure also extends the ability of a public body in any county in which the Governor has declared a state of emergency to meet by teleconference or videoconference, until the emergency declaration expires or is terminated. This language was originally written to expire on November 15, 2020, or the expiration of the Governor's declared emergency, whichever occurred first.
