**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for SB1055 appropriates \$2.5 million to the Office of Juvenile Affairs to updated the Children's Emergency Resource Center rates. The measure also allots \$750,000 for purchasing vocational equipment, \$150,000 for hiring two workforce development specialists, \$1.957 million for program development and enhancements, and \$1.715 million to increase funding for the transitional community housing and independent program. Appropriations may be budgeted for FY23 or FY24.

**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1055 CS directs the Office of Juvenile Affairs to spend 2.5 million on children's emergency resource centers rates, 750k to purchase vocational equipment, 150k on for hiring 2 workforce development specialists, \$1,957,000 for program development and enhancements, and \$1,715,000 to increase funding for transitional community housing and independent program.
