**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for SB 1110 authorizes the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to fund universities to study methods of conducting remote inspections of meat and poultry products. If ODAFF determines there is suitable technology, it is to apply for approval with the appropriate federal agency. If approved, ODAFF shall promulgate rules for a university-conducted pilot program for remote inspections and the footage is to be kept confidential by the university and ODAFF. Remote inspections are for intrastate commerce only, unless the federal agency approves it for interstate commerce.
