**Research Analysis**

SB 1179 provides that training in the Department of Veteran Affairs may occur individually pursuant to the Quality Workforce for Oklahoma's Heroes Act. Additionally, the measure authorizes the Department to utilize training programs through private schools and entities, in addition to public schools and entities provided for in current law. The measure clarifies the period of time an employee or prospective employee must be with the Department for certain reimbursements.

The measure declares an emergency.
