Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to SB 1229 authorizes the usage of funds from the Highway Construction Materials Technician Certification Revolving Fund by the Department of Transportation for the purposes of training and the certification of individuals seeking to become registered highway construction materials technicians. The measure repeals Title-69 Sections 1951 through 1962 and 1964, which relate to the Oklahoma Highway Construction Materials Technician Registration Act. Repealing these sections eliminates the Highway Construction Materials Technician Certification Board and removes all duties of the Board regarding the revolving fund.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 1229 eliminates the Highway Construction Materials Technician Certification Board (HCMTCB) and assigns such duties and revolving fund to the Department of Transportation (ODOT). Under existing law ODOT provides staffing and administrative assistance to the HCMTCB, including the current administration of the revolving fund. Officials from ODOT view the measure as a streamlining of process that is not expected to result in the need for increased appropriations.
