Research Analysis

The engrossed version of SB 1261 modifies the Combined Pesticide Law so that plaintiffs are only eligible for damages when their crops are insurable under the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation or the crops are directly sold by the producer to the consumer. If damages are awarded, they shall not exceed the amount of compensation a producer has received from proven yield from the affected area. If there is no proven yield, than the amount awarded shall not exceed an amount equal to the county average yield for the specific crop.
