**Research Analysis**

SB 1288 removes the requirement for the Governor to appoint licensed professional counselors from a list of qualified candidates submitted by the Executive Committee of the Oklahoma Counseling. It also removes the requirement that appointees who are licensed marital and family therapists be selected from a list of qualified candidates submitted by the Oklahoma Association for Marriage and Family Therapy. Lastly, it removes the requirement that appointees who are licensed behavioral therapists be selected from a list of candidates submitted by the National Association for Masters in Psychology.
