## **Research Analysis**

The substitute to SB 1300 exempts vehicles that are 20 years old or older from the requirement that an odometer disclosure statement be executed upon transfer. The measure provides that on or after January 1, 2022, that any registration fee required for a physically disabled license plate is to be remitted at the same time and subject to a single registration period. The measure also requires the Oklahoma Tax Commission to send notifications of renewal for special license plates to the electronic mail address provided by the holder of the plate. If a person does not provide an electronic mail address, the Tax Commission is to notify the person by mail.
