## **Research Analysis**

SB 1333 clarifies that the Union Soldiers Cemetery located in Oklahoma City on Northeast 36th Street and Martin Luther King Avenue is to remain under the supervision of the Adjutant General of the State of Oklahoma until a clear title to property has been established after which it will be transferred to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. The measure also repeals <u>Title 44 Section 118</u>, which relates to the Union Soldiers Home - Evaluation, Report and Authorization.
