**Research Analysis**

SB 1338 amends the definition of *tetrahydrocannabinols* as used in the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act to mean delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) and all isomers, precursors, and other variations of THC, including delta-8 or delta-10 THC. The measure classifies THC as a Schedule I substance, excluding delta-8 THC in a concentration of not more than 2 percent and any THC specifically excepted or listed in a different schedule, including delta-9 THC, which remains a Schedule III substance.
