**Research Analysis**

SB 1351 authorizes the Transportation Commission to compromise, settle, or litigate claims against a person, firm or corporation for damages to or loss of property, equipment or facilities belonging to the Department of Transportation for claims exceeding the amount of \$5,000. The Director of Transportation or their designee will compromise, settle, or litigate all other claims.
