Research Analysis

Engrossed SB1364 requires that for elections held after July 1, 2022, any state agency, board, or commission that owns or leases a facility located near or in a precinct without a suitable polling place shall make space within the facility available for use as a polling place upon written request of the secretary of the county election board. Additionally, for elections held after July 1, 2022, any political subdivision that held an election conducted by a county election board on or before Jan. 1, 2018 that owns, rents, or leases a facility located in or near a precinct without a suitable facility, shall make space for use of a polling place upon written request of the county election board secretary. A reasonable maintenance or cleaning fee may be charged to the county election board for use of the facility.

In its current form, SB 1364 is not expected to have a direct fiscal impact on the State Election Board's budget. The measure may have a fiscal impact on county elections boards, though the impacts are expected to be routine and not substantial.
