Research Analysis

The committee substitute (CS) to SB 1369 creates the Office of the State Coordinator for Health Information Exchange within the Oklahoma Health Care Authority. The CS provides the powers and duties of the Office. The measure adds and strikes certain definitions. The CS requires the State of Oklahoma to serve or designate the state-designated entity for health information exchange.

The CS strikes statutory language and references regarding health information exchange certification, Oklahoma Statewide Health Information Exchange (OKHIE), and the purpose of Oklahoma State Health Information Network and Exchange (OKSHINE).

The CS requires all health care entities licensed in this state to report data to and utilize the state designated entity. The Office of the State Coordinator for Health Information Exchange may allow exemptions on the basis of financial hardship, size, or technological capability of a health care entity or such other bases provided by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board. The measure updates statutory references and declares an emergency.
