Research Analysis

SB 1369 creates the Oklahoma Healthcare Transparency Initiative Act of 2022 and the Office of the State Coordinator for Health Information Exchange within the Oklahoma Health Care Authority. The measure specifies the powers and duties of the Office of the State Coordinator for Health Information Exchange which include implementing and governing the Oklahoma Healthcare Transparency Initiative. The State of Oklahoma will serve as or will designate the state designated entity for health information exchange. All health care entities licensed and located in the state are required to report data to and utilize the state designated entity while also allowing for exceptions to this requirement by the Office of the State Coordinator for Health Information Exchange. The bill strikes all statutory references of OKSHINE or OKHIE and replaces it with "the state designated entity" and provides legislative intent of the Oklahoma Healthcare Transparency Initiative Act.

A submitting entity as specified in the measure is required to submit claims data, unique identifiers, and geographic and demographic information for covered individuals as permitted in the act and provider files to the Oklahoma Healthcare Transparency Initiative. The measure provides the criteria for data in the Oklahoma Healthcare Transparency Initiative to be available. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board is required to adopt a schedule of penalties not to exceed \$1000.00 per day for each day the violation occurs.

The State Department of Health is required to submit all public health data and vital statistics data to the Oklahoma Healthcare Transparency Initiative for integration into the Initiative database. The measure modifies, strikes, and adds certain definitions and declares an emergency.
