Research Analysis

The floor substitute (FA1) to SB 1369 creates the Office of the State Coordinator for Health Information Exchange within the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA). FA1 provides that the Office will oversee the state-designated entity for health information exchange.

FA1 directs the State of Oklahoma to:

- designate a health information exchange organization as the state-designated entity
- establish a transition plan and;
- may temporarily serve as the state-designated entity as part of the transition plan

The measure strikes the requirement of OHCA to establish a health information exchange certification with certain requirements and also strikes the purpose of the Oklahoma Health Information Network.

All health care providers as defined by the rules promulgated by OHCA Board are required to report data to and utilize the state-designated entity. FA1 allows the Office of the State Coordinator for Health Information Exchange to allow exemptions from this requirement. The measure updates all statutory references regarding "the state-designated entity."

Lastly, FA1 modifies and strikes certain definitions from the measure and declares an emergency.
