Fiscal Analysis

The measure, as engrossed, would require the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training to include de-escalation, crisis intervention, and mental health management in the minimum curriculum requirements for security guard, armed security guard, and private investigator training.

Upon review and with consultation from CLEET, passage of the measure would create a minimal and absorbable impact to the agency. The provisions of the measure would require personnel to devote work-hours to implement.
