## **Research Analysis**

SB 1374 expands the State Fire Marshal's jurisdiction for yearly fire inspections of correctional facilities to include facilities under the jurisdiction or control of any public trust. The measure also removes and replaces building classifications to align with all codes adopted by the Uniform Building Code Commission pursuant to the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission Act.

Additionally, the measure expands the list of entities subject to payment of fines, not to exceed \$1,000 per day, for failing to comply with State Fire Marshal laws to include partnerships, organizations, cities, towns, school districts, counties or other subdivisions of government. Any person or entity who is fined has the right to a hearing and should request one within 10 business days of the fine notice. The State Fire Marshal will preside over the hearing and issue a proposed order containing proposed findings of fact and present them to the State Fire Marshal Commission. Once reviewed, the State Fire Marshal Commission may adopt, modify or deny the proposal from the State Fire Marshal and should issue a final order to all parties involved. Any party aggrieved by the final order may appeal to the district court.

Finally, the measure requires that all fines collected be deposited into the State Fire Marshal Revolving Fund and removes the cap previously placed on the State Fire Marshall Revolving Fund.
