## **Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB1393 amends an exemption from the Home Care Act to extend the supervision requirement for an individual who only provides Medicaid home-and community-based personal care services from supervision every month to ever 6 months, provided the client does not experience a significant change in health. The measure directs the home care agency to develop a written training plan for the individual that must include observation and documentation of client status, maintenance of a clean environment, recognizing emergency procedures, techniques for grooming and bathing assistance, assistance with meal preparation, client rights and responsibilities, and basic infection control practices. The measure strikes language related to supportive home assistants.
