**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute (PCS1) to SB 1393 strikes provisions relating to supportive home assistants and training. PCS1 also requires home health care agencies to develop a written training plan for home health aides that will include certain requirements. The measure modifies the requirement of an individual who only provides Medicaid home and community-based personal care services to be supervised by a registered nurse via on-site visit at least once every month to once every six months.

PSC1 requires the State Department of Health to promulgate rules and regulations. The measure updates statutory references.
