Research Analysis

SB 1413 requires health benefit plans offering coverage for mental health and substance use disorder benefits to include in their findings and conclusions in the annual report sufficient detail to fully explain such findings such as the methodologies for the analyses, detailed descriptions of each treatment limitation, and detailed descriptions of all criteria involved for approving mental health and substance use disorder benefits. The measure directs the Insurance Commissioner to issue guidance and standardized reporting templates. Any information that is confidential or a trade secret will be redacted prior to public posting. The measure updates statutory language to comply with federal law.
