**Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB143 allows the presentation of recognition awards as part of a county employee benefit program at formal or informal ceremonies, banquets, receptions or lunches, but the cost of the ceremony would be expended from the county department or division's operating fund.

**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 143 in its current form authorizes boards of county commissioners to host recognition reward ceremonies. The measure includes permissive language and does not mandate such ceremonies. The measure has no direct fiscal impact on the state budget or state revenues.
