Research Analysis

The floor substitute to SB 1430 increases the maximum speed allowed to motorized scooters to 35 miles per hour and increases the piston or rotor displacement from 35 cu cm to 50 cu cm. It also establishes that the operator must be at least 14 years of age. Finally, the measure allows local governments to set the maximum speed requirements and allows municipalities to determine appropriate locations for use and to regulate usage of motorized scooters on all public roadways.

Fiscal Analysis

The first floor amendment to the measure is a floor substitute. The amendment would modify the definition of motorized scooter and provide municipalities with the authority to regulate the usage of motorized scooters.
