## **Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 1444 modifies quorum requirements for meetings of rural electric co-ops. The measure requires in-person registrations to be counted toward the required five percent of members necessary to constitute a quorum. Any vote taken at a time when fewer than 5 percent of members are present can only be taken on proposed actions that were specifically identified and provided to the members in advance through the meeting notice.
