SB 1452 excludes from the definition of "record" as used in the Oklahoma Open Records Act any portion of any document or information provided to an agency or entity of the state or a political subdivision to obtain licensure under the laws of this state or a political subdivision that contains an applicant's personal address, phone number, electronic mail address, or other contact information. The measure also requires public bodies that provide utility services to the public to redact personal electronic mail addresses and any portion of any record that contains the name or any other identifier of the occupants of any residential structure.
