Research Analysis

SB 1532 provides that on or after November 1, 2022, a district or municipal court is to waive all outstanding fines, court costs, and fees in a criminal case for any person who has made installment payments on outstanding fines, court costs, fees, and restitution ordered by the court on a timely basis for forty-eight (48) months in the previous sixty-month period including any payments made prior to the effective date of this act. To be eligible for a waiver pursuant to this subsection, the person shall have complied with all probation or supervision requirements as ordered by the court.
