Research Analysis

SB 1542 provides that no provisions of the Physician Assistant Act will limit the activities of a physician assistant in the performance of their duties employed by or under contract with the federal government. Such persons must be licensed as physician assistants by the state or another state or credentialed by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs or the applicable uniform service. Any physician assistant employed by the government will be subject to the Physician Assistant Act's provisions while practicing outside of the federal system.
