**Research Analysis**

SB 155 directs the Oklahoma Supreme Court to maintain a calendar of cases pending before the court and to publish the calendar on its website. Entries on the calendar must include dates the court is to hear oral arguments, cases challenging the constitutionality of an act of the Legislature, dates of court conferences, dates the court is closed, and any information that will assist the public in monitoring cases. Entries noting oral arguments must include the case number, names, counsel of record, and a summary of the case. The Supreme Court must also update weekly a list of cases for which it has granted review.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure provides that the Oklahoma Supreme Court shall maintain a calendar of cases pending before the court. The measure provides that the calendar shall be made available to the public on the Supreme Court website and include certain information.

Upon review and with consultation from the Administrative Office of the Courts, the measure may have an impact on the budget of the Supreme Court. The initial creation of the public, online calendar will not involve a direct cost to the Court. However, the ongoing maintenance and operation of the calendar may require additional funding for a full-time equivalent (FTE) employee.
