## **Research Analysis**

SB 1565 gives the Attorney General the power to cross-deputize police officers of the police department of any municipality or any officer deputized by the county sheriff or a designee subject to an interlocal governmental agreement with the Attorney General's Office in an effort to combine city, county, and state law enforcement efforts and to encourage cooperation between city, county, and state law enforcement officials. The measure provides that liability for any conduct of the officer remains with the respective employer of the officer.

## Fiscal Analysis

The measure, as engrossed, would allow the Office of the Attorney General to cross-deputize local law enforcement subject to an interlocal governmental agreement.
