**Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB1579 authorizes a school district board of education to approve a district employee's request for a leave of absence to hold office for a national, statewide, or local employee association. Leave granted will be leave without pay. The employee must provide proof of election and term of office.

Following the term of leave, the employee may return to their former position or a comparable position. During the leave period the employee's position shall be maintained without advancement on the minimum salary schedule, and with no accrual of sick leave, or personal leave.
