**Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB1631 requires the Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability to establish a two-year pilot program for mentor teacher training with the goal of providing training to one mentor teacher from each school district over a two year period. Mentor teachers will be given a one-time stipend of \$3,000 subject to the availability of funds.

The program shall provide mentor teachers, with at least 5 years teaching experience, with coaching tools to guide and support teachers in the areas of classroom management, differentiation of instruction, and other pedagogical techniques.
