Research Analysis

SB 1632 requires the Attorney General to publish all written opinions in connection with the interpretation of the laws of Oklahoma electronically and in a manor that is accessible to the public at no cost. The measure also allows the Attorney General to print written opinions in bound volumes at his or her discretion.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure, as engrossed, would modify the procedure for the publication of Attorney General opinions. The measure would require the Office of the Attorney General to publish opinions in an electronic format that is accessible to the public at no charge. The measure would allow the Office of the Attorney General to print physical copies of opinions at the office's discretion.

Upon review and with consultation from the Office of the Attorney General, passage of the measure may generate savings for the state of approximately \$10,000. By allowing the office to electronically publish opinions and providing for discretion in publishing physical copies, the measure could reduce printing costs borne by the Office of the Attorney General.
