SB 169 directs the Oklahoma Tax Commission to enter into licensing agreements with organizations for any licensing fees that may be required to use the organization's logo or design as it relates to special license plates. The licensing fee per plate may not exceed \$20.00 per plate issued.

Fiscal Analysis

Analysis provided by the Tax Commission:

The measure proposes for purposes of financial assistance special license plates created pursuant to 47 O.S. § 1135.7 to authorize the Tax Commission ("OTC") to enter into a licensing agreement with an organization for any licensing fees that may be required to use the organization's logo or design. The annual fee for financial assistance special license plate issued pursuant to Section 1135.7(E) of Title 47 is \$35. Pursuant to the proposed licensing agreement, an amount not to exceed \$20 shall be transferred monthly to that organization as payment for the licensing fees and no fees shall be apportioned to the License Plate Special Program Assistance Revolving Fund created in 47 O.S. § 1135.8. Further, \$8 of the \$35 fee shall be deposited in the OTC Reimbursement Fund to be used for administrative purposes associated with issuance of the special license plates and any remaining amounts apportioned as motor vehicle collections pursuant to the provisions of 47 O.S. § 1104.

The analysis indicates the provisions of the measure will have no revenue or fiscal considerations.
