The floor substitute to SB 169 modifies the definitions relating to cocktails-to-go. The measure modifies the definition of "original container" to provide that the container must be secured with a tamper-evident lid or cap by the original manufacturer of the mixed drink.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

The first floor amendment to the measure is a floor substitute. The amendment would modify the definition of "original container" as found in the Cocktails to Go Act to include tamper-evident lids or caps originally included by manufacturers.

Upon review, no direct fiscal impact to the state is anticipated from passage of the measure. The measure does not affect state revenues or require additional state expenditures.
