## **Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 1696 streamlines the expiration of annual hunting and fishing licenses to expire one year after their issue date, rather than June 30 or December 31. Unless otherwise specified, all other licenses shall expire on December 31 the year it was purchased.

These are the licenses that are adjusted:

- Annual hunting license for nonresidents hunting game other than deer, antelope, elk or bear
- Annual hunting license for residents and resident youth
- Annual combination hunting/fishing license for residents and resident youth
- Annual fishing license for residents and resident youth
- Annual fishing license for nonresidents
