Research Analysis

SB 17 requires the lethality assessment used to assess the victim of domestic violence be available on the Attorney General's website. The measure requires an officer conducting a lethality assessment on a potential domestic abuse victim to implement the protocol referral process to a domestic violence advocate from a certified or tribal program in a manner outlined in the measure. Regardless of the results of the lethality assessment, referral information for shelters, domestic violence programs and other social services must be provided to the victim.
