SB 170 authorizes the court, after authorizing the withdrawal of life-sustaining medical treatment or the denial of the administration of cardiopulmonary resuscitation on behalf of a child under the custody of the Department of Human Services, to allow anatomical gifts to be procured from the child.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure provides for judicial authorization of anatomical gifts from children in the custody of the Department of Human Services after authorizing the withdrawal of life-sustaining medical treatment or denial of the administration of cardiopulmonary resuscitation.
