The CS to SB 171 prohibits the court clerk from publishing court records on its website if the cases involve rape, sodomy, sex crimes, sexual images, lewd or indecent conduct, pornography, child abuse or neglect, domestic abuse, kidnapping, extortion of a vulnerable victim, human trafficking or similar offenses.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure prohibits the court clerk from publishing court records on its website if the cases involve rape, sodomy, sex crimes, sexual images, lewd or indecent conduct, pornography, child abuse or neglect, domestic abuse, kidnapping, extortion of a vulnerable victim, human trafficking or similar offenses.
