## **Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB1711 modifies the duties of the Attorney General by requiring them to monitor and evaluate any federal government action included Presidential executive orders, rules or regulations promulgated by a federal agency or acts of Congress, and practice or policy that infringes on an individual's religious liberties in the workplace. The state, county, political subdivision or any other publicly funded organization will not implement, adopt or enforce any order, federal agency rules or federal congressional action declared unconstitutional dealing with the protection of religious liberties in the workplace.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

The measure, as engrossed, would authorize the Office of the Attorney General to monitor and evaluate federal government actions that infringes on an individual's religious liberties in the workplace. The measure would also prohibit the state, political subdivisions, or any other publicly funded organization from implementing a federal action that is found unconstitutional regarding the protection of religious liberties in the workplace.

Upon review, no direct fiscal impact is anticipated from passage of the measure. The measure contains permissive language.
